We are working on:

Language Arts:

- Recognizing and forming the letters L, N, B & P, and learning their sound.
- Listen to stories based on our themes (i.e Goodbye Summer Hello Autumn, Leaf Man, Bats in the Library, Spookley the Square Pumpkin).

Math:

- Focus on writing and recognizing numbers 1 &
 2.
- Our shape is square.
- Counting to 31 as we follow the calendar, stopping on tens.

Science:

- We will observe the changing of the leaves and learn why it occurs.
- We will be learning about nocturnal and diurnal animals.
- We will explore pumpkins and their life cycle.

Art

- Our color is orange.
