What we will be working on..

Language Arts:

- Learning to recognize and identify the sounds of letters Z, R & U.
- Review all vowels and discuss their importance.
- Reading stories related to our themes, such as, *Cat in the Hat*, *The Lorax*, *Click Clack Moo*, *Planting a Rainbow* and *How the Crayons Saved the Rainbow*.

Math:

Science:
